

LOCAL TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE FUNDS APPLICATION

A total of \$50,000 is available for local boards to access technical assistance and support learning between January 1, 2016 and December 31, 2016. Each local board will be eligible to receive up to \$5,000 and the local boards are required to match 25% of the total investment in technical assistance. For example, a project which costs \$5,000 can be funded with \$3,750 in grant funds along with \$1,250 of local investment. (For projects costing more than \$5,000 the local WDB must invest at a higher rate). Workforce areas may apply for technical assistance individually, or as consortia to address common needs.

Technical assistance funding should be used to address a need or needs addressed in the local area's self-assessment. Boards will be held accountable for the use of funds in alignment with these identified needs and the intended activities described in this application.
