12:01PM CALL TO ORDER

John Lyons, KWIB Executive Director, welcomed everyone and called the meeting to order and introduced the new Chair, Beth Davisson, KY Chamber.

Beth Davisson thanked everyone for their interest and asked that this committee problem-solve and work through bottlenecks and build solutions. She thanked Kevin Smith, KWIB Chair, for reaching out to her to be

chair and asked him if he would like to speak. Kevin thanked the educators and thanked the employers with whom we cannot make impact on our young people through apprenticeships, co-ops and on the job training. Beth walked through the agenda briefly and asked that the members take 30 seconds each and identify themselves, and their hopes for the work of this committee.

Committee work Themes by the committee members include:

- Progress in education and development of workforce opportunities
- Using the *data* we have and *building out data literacy* that all counties, regions and education and economic structures can use
- Increasing awareness of workforce paths in Early Childhood
- Tying *work streams* (by industry) together
- Finding workforce solutions; strengthening the collaboration
- Making sure to capture all *disadvantaged populations* and offer paths for each
- Deliver *concrete solutions to employers* who provide *employment paths* through internships, co-ops and apprenticeships
- Bridge gap in communicating the education paths available to students (CPE or certifications, etc.)
- *Educate employers* of the existing benefits in employing those under 18
- Encourage employers to provide WBL and counseling on required skills to youth
- Linking priorities of CPE with work options needed in KY
- Get better data on drop outs and paths to offer and how best to communicate
- Paths of continued education once in the workforce; planning for the future of work in KY
- Championing technology across ALL industry sectors important in KY; *invest in ESG* (Environmental Social Governance)
- Help translate what students learn into employment options and pathways are
- Provide a student's perspective
- Providing a path for students to a *career pathway*
- Help underserved populations into career pathways like construction
- Streamline engagement from all resources (cabinet, employers, education, assistance programs, etc.)

Beth explained that another initiative of this **committee is to break down barriers**. One such opportunity explained by **Kylie Whitaker of CTE** (Office of Career and Technical Education):

Legislation passed in KRS 158.6455 - Based on data from the Kentucky Center for Education and Workforce Statistics, each local workforce investment board, in conjunction with local economic development organizations from its state regional sector, shall annually compile a list of industry-recognized certifications, licensures, and credentials specific to the state and regional workforce area, rank them by demand for the state and regional area, and provide the list to the Kentucky Workforce Innovation Board. The Kentucky Workforce Innovation Board, in conjunction with the Kentucky Department of Education, may revise the lists before the Kentucky Department of Education disseminates the lists to all school districts to be used as postsecondary readiness indicators.

The chair raised a *motion* to create a subcommittee to help with continuous improvement and added employer engagement in the CTE Industry Certification Process. *Scott Pierce* seconded the motion. The **motion carried** with no one dissenting.

Beth mentioned meeting cadence over the next couple of months. Debbie Dennison will send invitations, for a one-hour meeting, to the committee for 2/25/21 and 3/24/21 at noon.

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WIBs Use Data to Recommend Changes to KWIB

- WIBs are not required to follow one set process for how this is accomplished
- WIBs in the past have each had their own process
- KDE would love to get our original list back with your modifications/deletions/additions



KWIB passes Recommendations to KDE/KDE consultants meet with Business/Education for Industry Certification Alignment to Career Pathways

- Each of the 10 KDE program areas will convene Employers, National Organizations, and both a Postsecondary and Secondary teacher related to their area
- The main purpose is to review the WIB changes to determine if the certifications can be earned by high school students and to align those certifications to pathways

KDE meets with KWIB Education & Employer Engagement Committee/Committee makes recommendations to full KWIB

- KDE will take the aligned certifications from the program area meetings to the KWIB
 Education & Employer Engagement
 Committee
- The main purpose in this step is to talk through changes with the KWIB, determine final High Demand criteria, and make a recommendation to the full KWIB



Full KWIB Approves and/or Makes Final Changes to List/KDE Publishes Approved List

- KWIB meets to determine approval of the list and here recommendations from the Education & Employer Engagement subcommittee chair
- KWIB determines final changes and approval
- **KDE** publishes the final approved list
- **KDE** sends list to all stakeholders
