Heidi Margulis opened the meeting with <u>a brief overview of our goal</u> – to educate/inform as many cabinets, community agencies, local interested participants and others about the Benefit Cliffs Calculator and its tools, as well as to seek feedback as to uses and where policy barriers exist that prevent individuals from seeking/accepting employment opportunities due to such cliffs.

Heidi requested four (4) items requiring feedback with the goal in mind as follows:

- 1. She asked for a list of agencies or individuals that needed to be involved in this effort
- 2. She asked for a list of groups that should be included and trained to use the tool (what offices, agencies, end users benefit?)
- 3. She asked that a feedback form be created to identify the biggest "problem areas" or policy barriers (e.g. which benefits keep people from entering/reentering the work force?)
- 4. Based on the feedback from Item 3, what current policies should be reviewed /considered for changes to enable greater workforce participation?

Questions / comments from members:

- **Dr. Fister** suggested that <u>Resource Centers</u> be included, if they haven't ; asked if there were <u>a video</u> (tutorial) that could be directed to whoever could use / train others; asked about <u>filters on the site</u> and Kris provided an option to click on
- Jessica / Kris said they are working on a <u>walk through tutorial</u> and hope to have something in the next week or so (Holly suggested a flyer for this) <u>http://frs.nccp.org/tools/frs/</u> and they will be emailing out to the committee members
- Amanda Flanary suggested <u>Head Start</u> as a conduit and will provide information on <u>John Mountjoy</u> who could assist; she also offered to facilitate a presentation with the Head Start Directors; also suggested <u>local childcare</u> centers across KY; <u>Rehabilitation Centers</u>; <u>"Save the Children" foundation</u>; also mentioned <u>conferences</u> (when they resume) like <u>EC Institute</u>, substance abuse programs, etc.
- Shauna King-Simms suggested reaching out to the Prichard committee and provided Brigitte Blom Ramsey <u>admin@prichardcommittee.org;</u> suggested <u>KY Coalition Against Domestic Violence</u> – <u>amiller@kcadv.org</u>; Wilbur, Lorraine (CHFS DCBS DPP) <u>Lorraine.Wilbur@ky.gov</u> with DCBS Foster Youth. Suggested reaching out to Voc Rehab, Pre-employment at KCTCS, and DCBS Independent Living Specialists Offered to set up a session with Ready to Work coordinators to view the tools.
- Todd Trapp <u>CHFS DCBS</u> said we could reach out to <u>23 Community Action Agency</u> locations and LIHEAP
