CALL TO ORDER

Kim Menke, Chair, called the meeting to order at 8:33am. He provided a brief summary of the agenda and welcomed the members.

Introduction of Members

Mr. Menke asked each of those in attendance to introduce themselves, provide information on their role and to identify their first job.





Review of Goals Committee's

Mr. Menke reviewed the following Strategic plan goals for the committee:

- Identify and Address Organizational Structure of State Government to Improve Collaboration/Accountability
- Develop framework of Goals and Metrics for Programs
- Identify Gaps in Data Systems and identify available sources
- Define and Create Communication Approach for services
- Build a stronger and more coordinated relationship between state & local government, institutions and workforce areas

As he talked through each goal, he asked the committee members to think of where their interests and expertise lie within the above.

Direction and Focus of Structure and Alignment objectives

Mr. Menke shared focus and alignment objectives of the committee to review current resources and funding provided to those resources, and to identify gaps and re-align as necessary. The committee will seek to review experiences, expectations of job seekers, employers and service providers to assess what current activity is to what gaps exist and then suggest realignment as necessary.

Gaps identified included:

- Employer *education / awareness* of existing services offered within the Education and Workforce Development (EWD) Cabinet
- Effective communication to employers, job seekers, and services providers
- Understanding what *motivates* job seekers to search for employment
- Better connectivity and alignment with all stakeholders is important (Local WIBs, other EWD committees, KY Chamber, local libraries)
- Tracking funding streams in addition to captured WIOA funds in the state
- Understanding of programs/partners/services/limitations on funding and/or target groups

Committee Next steps

Mr. Menke asked the members to send their participation interests to KWIB staff; Sub-committees will be created around plan initiatives with special attention to gaps identified; Continue to review other state workforce delineation of funds – ie. Texas and Florida

Mr. Menke asked that KWIB staff send out polling information for remaining meetings this year.
