Career Development Office Overview

The Kentucky Career Center and the Career Development Office (CDO)

- CDO is a required partner of the comprehensive Kentucky Career Centers,
- CDO provides job search assistance, job order posting, resources and a referral pipeline for job seekers.





CDO Programs

- Foreign Labor Certification (FLC),
- Jobs for Veterans State Grant (JVSG),
- Reemployment Services and Eligibility Assessments (RESEA),
- Trade Act programs (TAA), and
- Wagner-Peyser (WP) services.

Foreign Labor Certification (FLC)

 Provides services for nonimmigrant workers (H-2A workers) to perform agricultural labor or services of a temporary or seasonal nature in the United States when there are not sufficient workers.



Jobs for Veterans State Grant (JVSG)

- Assists eligible job seeking Veterans, Transitioning Service Members, and eligible family members with basic and intensive employment services,
- Serves as Veteran Liaison on the Business Service Team and works to connect Employers and Veterans.



Reemployment Services and Eligibility Assessments (RESEA)

- Assists UI claimants deemed likely to exhaust benefits prior to obtaining employment,
- Provides a comprehensive assessment of the customers skills and potential barriers, and develops an individual employment plan and goals,
- Connects the customer to resources, partners and employment.




Trade Act Programs (TAA)

- Assists individuals who have lost their job through foreign trade and impacted industry,
- Provides extended unemployment insurance benefits, basic and intensive employment services and training opportunities to eligible individuals.



Wagner-Peyser

Wagner-Peyser is the nationwide system of public employment services, such as:





Business Services

- Job fairs, hiring events & job postings,
- Interview & orientation space,
- Testing and prescreening services,
- Conduct workshops for potential or current employees,
- Data and LMI (UI rate, commuting patterns, labor force, participation rate, etc.) for expansion, new business and growth,
- Connect to partner programs for training, tax credits, bonding and other resources.



Job Seeker Services

- Resume preparation assistance,
- Individualized assessments and employment plans,
- Connection and referrals to partners and resources to overcome barriers,
- Connect to training, work-based learning opportunities and other resources,
- Assistance connecting to and obtaining employment.



Rapid Response Services: Layoffs & Closures

CDO & the Business Service Team is comprised of multiple partners who are available to assist businesses who are in layoff status or closure by providing support for employees
