Household Survey

- **Employed:** People who worked for pay
- **Unemployed:** Those who did not work for pay but *searched* for work during the past 4 weeks


$$\text{Labor Force} = \# \text{ Employed} + \# \text{ Unemployed}$$

- **Not in Labor Force:** People who are not employed and *not searching* for work


$$\text{Unemployment Rate} = \frac{\text{Unemployed}}{\text{Labor Force}}$$

Unemployment Rates 2007 to June 2020




Kentucky's Unemployment Rate January 2020 to June 2020




Kentucky & US Employment to Population Ratio January 2020 to July 2020
