
Adult Education & Family Literacy Act (AEFLA) Eligible Service Providers:

- \star a local education agency,
- a community-based literacy or faith-based organization,
- ★ a volunteer literacy organization,
- ★ an institution of higher education,
- ★ a public or private nonprofit agency
- ★ a library,
- ★ a public housing authority

- ★ a nonprofit institution that is not described previously and has the ability to provide literacy services to eligible individuals,
- ★ a consortium or coalition of agencies, organizations, institutions, libraries, or authorities described previously,
- a partnership between an employer and an entity described above.

Adult Education & Family Literacy Act (AEFLA) Grant Process in Kentucky:

- ★ 3 Year Cycle Applicants apply in FY24 for example, for the next 3 FY starting July 1, 2025 and running through June 30, 2028
- ★ Applicants are all required to submit the same documentation, including narratives to address the AEFLA law, budgetary information, and demonstrated effectiveness from the past performance seasons
- This year, outside reviewers will be doing all the reading and scoring of submissions, removing any concern for bias at the local level – These reviewers are stakeholders in or adult education professionals from outside OAE
