Household Survey


- **Employed:** People who worked for pay
- **Unemployed:** Those who did not work for pay but *searched* for work during the past 4 weeks

Labor Force = # Employed + # Unemployed


 Not in Labor Force: People who are not employed and *not* searching for work

Unemployment Rate =
$$\frac{\text{Unemployed}}{\text{Labor Force}}$$


Unemployment Rates 2007 to June 2020 Kentucky & U.S.




Kentucky's Unemployment Rate January 2020 to June 2020




Kentucky & US Employment to Population Ratio January 2020 to July 2020
