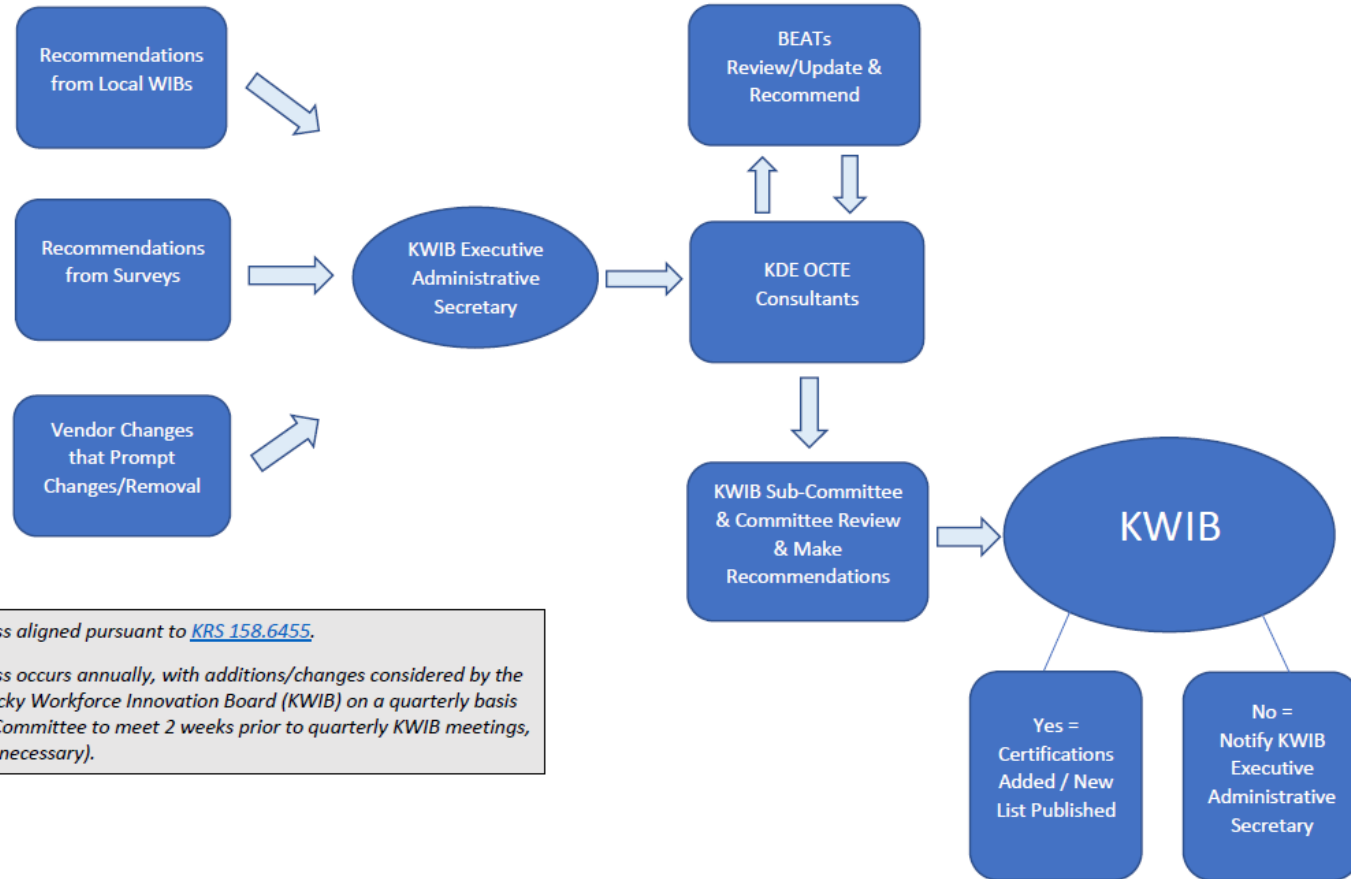

Process aligned pursuant to [KRS 158.6455](#).
Process occurs annually, with additions/changes considered by the Kentucky Workforce Innovation Board (KWIB) on a quarterly basis (Sub-Committee to meet 2 weeks prior to quarterly KWIB meetings, when necessary).

Certification Submissions Process

- Uniform submission process
- Form to capture
 - Contact information
 - Local workforce development area
 - Certification information
 - Business/Industry requesting the certification
- Submission form on KWIB website
 - KWIB will distribute recommendations to local WIBs
