This certification does not align to a specific CTE pathway in the Program of Studies but is highly supported by Business and Industry and is recommended to be available for schools who choose to offer a local pathway.
Transportation	Non-applicable	NA	Equipment and Engine Training Council Certification	YES	The Transportation BEAT recommends the addition of the EETC certification to the Valid Industry Certification list based on BEAT committees review. This certification does not align to a specific CTE pathway in the Program of Studies but to a local pathway within a district.
Transportation	Non-applicable	NA	Mercury Marine Certification	NO	The Transportation BEAT team does not recommend this certification. There is very limited information about this certification available. Agriculture	Horticulture and Plant Science Systems	CIP 01.1101.00	Benz School of Floral Design Principles of Floral Design Certification	NO	The Agriculture BEAT does not recommend this certification. While the individuals that provided feedback agreed that the content covered by the certification is relevant, they noted that there was no performance component. To paraphrase their comments - floral design is a very hands on job and for a certification to hold value for employment/advancement there needs to be evidence that the certificate holder has demonstrated competency through the creation of an actual floral design.

The team recommends moving forward the MACC Tech and Equipment and Engine Training Council certifications above to the Education attainment and Employer engagement. They chose NOT to recommend moving forward the Mercury Marine Certification and the Floral Design certification requests.

A **motion to recommend** the BEATs team recommendations adopted by the sub-committee to the full Education Attainment and Employer Engagement committee **was made by Scott Pierce and a second motion was made by Regina Phillips**. The motion was unanimously approved with no one dissenting.
