11:00 AM WELCOME

Beth Davisson, Committee Chair, welcomed and thanked everyone for their commitment and walked through the agenda.

Beth introduced **Dr. Kish Kumi Price, Commissioner of the Department of Workforce Investment** to talk about the Governor's *Everybody Counts* program initiated at JCPS in Louisville. It is a pilot program that makes sure there are no students that are left behind. Dallas Kratzer asked if there was credit given as these students are on this career path and through blockchain type efforts, and yes the beta will be looking at how to connect the experience of the student. Anticipated that should be offered to nearly 3,000 eligible JCPS students out of possible 6,800.

Perkins Leadership Applications

Karla Tipton, Chair of the sub-committee walked through list of applicants and shared that through four (4) working groups, interviews were held, and applications are recommended for approval. This approval by the committee constitutes the motion to approve; second motion given by Dallas Kratzer. The Chair asked if there were any opposed and hearing none, the motion is approved to move to the full KWIB Board meeting on March 17, 2022.

Sector Strategy sub-committee update

Sara Tracy, Executive Director of the Total Pipeline Management (TPM) of the Kentucky Chamber and Chair of this sub-committee shared updates. The sub-committee is reviewing how to annually review sectors and grade their relevance as a primary sector to ensure the Commonwealth is focusing on job seeker and employer demand data.

Additionally, a joint sub-committee with the Opportunity Youth / Young Adults sub-committee is creating a working group to build a Work-based Learning Toolkit to market to and share with employers. A glossary as well as resources will be part of the toolkit. KWIB staff is currently pulling together resources for review and creating a base for this working group.

CTE Certification Continuous Improvements sub-committee update

David Horseman, Associate Commissioner of the Office of Career and Technical Education (OCTE) introduced **Regan Satterwhite**, who is the lead on receiving the certification requests from KWIB staff. Regan stated that there have been three (3) new certifications that have been received and their BEAT (Business and Employer Attainment Task Force) is reviewing.

KWIB staff will send out information to the Local WIB and Office of Employer and Apprenticeship Services resources to make sure to communicate with employers about the access and process for changing industry credentials through the KWIB site - visit https://kwib.ky.gov/Pages/index.aspx at the bottom of the homepage is the link to *request new CTE certification*.
